

FENCING REGULATIONS

Last update 25-04-2008

1. Organization

- a. The Fencing Committee of the 18th Maccabiah will be responsible for the Fencing competitions of the 18th Maccabiah.
- b. The Fencing competitions will be conducted according to the International Fencing Rules and Regulations. The French text will be binding.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee of the 18th Maccabiah and registered the Fencing competitions.
- d. Each participating country may enter up to five competitors for each of the individual events.
- e. Each participating country may enter one team of 4 competitors (3 + reserve) for the team competitions.
- f. In each category there must be a minimum of **three** countries in the male competition.
- g. In each category there must be a minimum of **two** countries in the female competition with a total minimum of **three** competitors.

2. Venues and times

- a. The Fencing Committee of the 18th Maccabiah will determine the venues and times of the Fencing competitions and teams will be notified accordingly.
- b. The Fencing Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions these decisions will be final.

3. System of competition

- a. **Men:** Individual and team competitions will be held in SABRE, FOIL and EPEE.
Women: Individual and team competitions will be held in SABRE, FOIL and EPEE.
- b. The competitions will be conducted according to F.I.E. regulations and according to the number of entries.
 - (1) Requests to change the order of classifications must be submitted to the Tournament Manager, and such changes will be implemented only with his permission.
 - (2) The Tournament Manager will announce all the names of the players and their nominated order simultaneously with each confrontation.

4. Referees

The Fencing Committee will select a Referees Committee, which in turn will appoint the referees of the competition.

5. General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete 18th Maccabiah Regulations, and must be read along with the instructions found in "Basic Rules and Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures".
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the "Basic Rules and Regulations", the regulations written here will apply and be binding.
